Norman Johnson Clark, 84, of Tulsa, passed away Friday, June 15, 2012. He was born 7 Feb 28 in Midland, MD, son of the late James Kirkwood and Mary Etta (Johnson) Clark. He attended Carnegie Institute of Technology in Pittsburg, PA where he studied Aeronautical Engineering withdrawing in 1946 to enlist in the Army Air Force serving as a weather technician in a B-29 Weather Recon Squadron based in Guam. He was called to service again in 1952 during the Korean War. The same year he married his beloved wife, Madeline Feucht

Clark. She passed away in 2008 after 55 years of marriage. Norman was assigned by the AF to Texas A&M University for graduate training in Meteorology and was awarded a Master of Science degree. His final assignment was as Commander of the 6th Weather Squadron (Mob) located at Tinker AFB near OKC. Colonel Clark retired from the AF 1 Jun 78 with 30 years of service. He worked for Embry Riddle as a Registrar, and volunteered with the Tulsa Air and Space Museum. Col. Clark was an ardent member of the 6WSAA and a regular attendee at the reunions. In Oct of 2009 he married Wilma Brakey, she preceded him in death a few months later. He is survived by his son, Doug Clark of Euless, TX and daughter, Debbie Milberger (Mark) of Tulsa; three grandchildren; two sisters, Helen LaPrade and Evelyn Burdette. A Memorial Service was held 20 June 12 in the chapel of Freeman Harris Funeral Home. Farewell Friend!

TSgt Jay Wagner Hartz, (Ret) USAF, 77, of Palmyra, passed away peacefully on Saturday, June 9, 2012 in The Good Samaritan Hospital, Lebanon. He was born Friday, 4 Jan 1935 in Annville Township to the late Jacob and Mary Ellen (Speraw)

Hartz. He was predeceased by his loving wife Virginia Anne Herwegh Hartz on 22 Dec 08. He was a 1952 graduate of Annville High School. He was a Veteran of the Korean and Vietnam Wars, and received numerous commendations and citations during his decorated career. He served in 6th
